



Start Quiz

You can choose settings such as **INSTANT FEEDBACK** and enabling a **HINT** button. **NOTE; the Reset Activity button** on the right. You would **only use this, as the graphic shows, to erase all progress and start the Study Mode process over**.



Next you will choose how many questions you want to tackle at one sitting. Your time is valuable, so this option allows you to take either a series of short quizzes as you have time, or if you have a whole day, take a few longer exams.



Next you will start to answer questions in the typical exam mode you are used to. **But in Study Mode** you will also be able to Tag a question for later review, and go back and forth between questions, use a HINT button to check which textbook and what page the question is from. **Reading the material in the textbook before answering a question** is a very strong learning method in preparing for your actual promotional exam.

#### **VERY IMPORTANT:** Under **MY SCORES** scroll down to **View Your Question History.**

Here, right on the screen, you can review your progress with all the material, as well as **Review the Correct Answer**, and **TAG** and **UNTAG** any question.

If you are studying only certain chapters of a textbook, **going directly to your Question History screen** you will be able to click on **Toggle Explanation to see the page #** where the question appears, and then **TAG** that question if the page number falls within one of those chapters. You can then choose to **show only questions from those chapters by selecting the Tagged for Review option** when specifying questions.
